Although there are still some diehards who would pass the North cards, most will open 1♥ and hear a 14 overcall. South has too much to give up on slam; he should cuebid 2♠ to show a limit-raise or better in hearts, (which West might well double to ensure the spade lead) then raise his partner's non-forcing call of 3♥ to 4♥. It doesn't feel right for South to explore for 3NT here. and indeed 4♥ on a spade lead will surely prove one of the less challenging declarer-play hands of the day. Ten tricks will be achieved almost everywhere.

After a strong notrump by South, North will transfer into hearts then offer a choice of contracts. But will he invite with 2NT at his second turn or jump to 3NT? Despite the absence of intermediates, the two honors in the long suit argue for the aggressive position. Still, it is pairs, and one needs to protect the plus score. The final contract should be 3♥ if North goes low, 4♥ if he takes the high road. Game can be defeated on a spade lead (though East might continue spades rather than shifting to clubs) but it might be allowed to make on a diamond lead, if the defenders are not careful.

The natural approach with the North cards is to open 1♦ in fourth chair and raise a 1♠ response to...? 4♣ is a splinter-jump, but North is deficient in keycards for that call. Maybe a jump to 4♠ to show a 'balanced' hand would be a wiser course? Today the lie of the cards is extremely favorable for N/S and the only issue is whether anyone will sneak a second overtrick through. Maybe if West tries to be a hero at trick one and underleads the ♥A, he might lose it. The hearts might go on the diamonds.

Wars have been fought over whether South's cards constitute a non-vulnerable overcall of 2♣ over 1♥ (no-one would bid if vulnerable... would they?). Today, whether South bids or passes, North will get spades into play and South will help him reach game, so the argument must be postponed for another day. Against 4♠ the defenders must cash their aces early. While few tables may misdefend, I'm sure most travelers will see a +480 or two (and maybe the odd +200 from a missed game?).

You'd imagine N/S will unopposed: 1♣ - 1♠ - 1NT — All Pass. On a diamond lead to the gueen and ace and a diamond return, declarer can try to go after clubs to establish his seventh trick. However, the defense can counter by shifting to spades at some point, leaving South with just six tricks when the spade finesse loses. One variation could come if East took his life in his hands and doubled 1. That might get his side to 2♦ — an easy make but of course the auction may well not end there. A score of 100 for either side should matchpoint very nicely.

However many diamonds North opens — I'd expect 1♦ to be popular but some will try 2♦ and maybe a few hotheads might open 3♦ — East will probably show the majors with a Michaels Cuebid and West rates to come to rest in 4♥. Of course a few Wests may justifiably get carried away and take their side to the extremely dangerous contract of 5♥. The trumps behave but West has to guess the spades, and if North has opened 1♦ declarer may well get them wrong. All things considered, +650 should score pretty decently for E/W.

Unless the West cards are in his range for a strong notrump, he will open 1♣ and East will respond 1♥. After a textbook double by South, N/S should be able to compete to 2♠, and it may not be straightforward for E/W to bid on to 3♣ over that. 3♣ is an easy make, with clubs lying in such friendly fashion — indeed some will concede the overtrick. By contrast, it would be much harder to bring home 2♠; declarer has no reason to pick off East's diamond honors, unless the defense give the game away.

West's cards may not constitute a 1♣ opening, but many hate to pass at pairs at this vulnerability. Assume West opens and North bids 3♥ —as would we all — then East bids 3♠. and West should surely bid 3NT to slow the auction down. With the ♠K onside and the restricted choice position in clubs yielding six tricks for West, he has no fewer than 12 winners, though on a diamond lead his heart might be in his boots. 4♠ on a heart lead produces only 11 tricks (so long as South hops up with ♦A at trick two and ingeniously shifts to a low club, and North then covers the first spade!)
