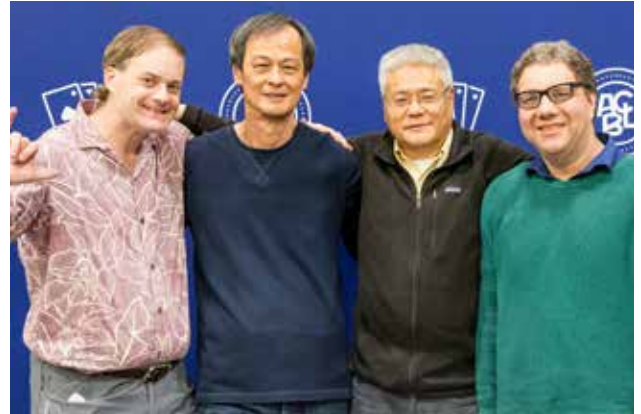

## Itabashi wins Mott-Smith

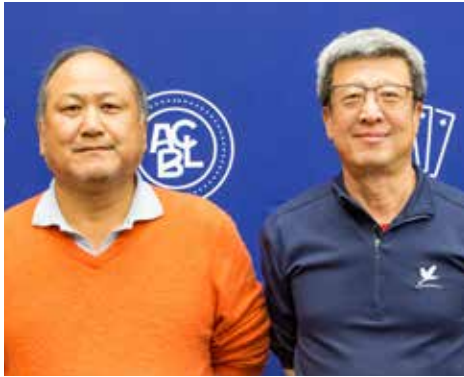

Sunday, representing District 16 (Texas). It's their second win this week after the 0-2500 Swiss Teams.

In Saturday's qualifying sessions, the Chens scored 57.34% and 63.14% to qualify in second place, about a third of a board behind the first-day leaders, Ping Hu and Henry Zhang of the Chicago area. A big 61.12% morning session on Sunday put them ahead by about two and a half boards, while the leaders dropped to third with an average session. A 52.38% last session sealed it, though the lead was down to 1.6 boards.

Henry Zhang and Peng Cheng of Saratoga CA (District 21) took second place.

"We didn't make many mistakes," Andrew said, and Charlie agreed.

They are Junior world champions, having won the Under-16 teams at the World Youth Transnationals last summer, and they have two other medals in world youth events.

have each won previous NABC titles with a surprising overlap of NABC Fast Pairs victories (though not with each other) and wins in Robot Individual contests. LaSota, Perlin and Yang have each won the Fast Pairs. Gu, the reigning Barry Crane Top winner/record holder, has won one Robot win, while Perlin has three, and LaSota is the all-time masterpoint-earner from robot games in ACBL history. Yang is the only member of the team to have previously won the Jacoby Swiss, in 2011.

In second was the team captained by Laurence Lebowitz of Boston MA. His teammates were Adam Grossack of Newton MA, Agustin Madala of Argentina, Dennis Bilde of Denmark, and brothers Ola Rimstedt and Mikael Rimstedt of Sweden.


