The other have all won multiple NABC titles, but it's the first win in this event for Korbel, Donn and Lee, while Padon and Birman won the Jacoby in 2023.

For Rippey of San Francisco, his international lineup included Baroni of Paris, France, Cima and Tadolini or Rome, Italy, and Bak and Marcinowski of Warsaw, Poland.

Of interest: Bailey and life partner Arti Bhargava – captain of the victorious squad in the Women's Swiss Teams (see story on pg. 1) – each won a national championship on the same day.

Also of note: Bailey was the developer of Deep Finesse, the famous double-dummy software.

It's the second national win for Bhargava and the first for the de Wijs sisters. Eythorsdottir has 10 previous national championships and one gold, two silver and two bronze medals in World Championship events.

"I had the best teammates," said Bhargava. "Disa may be a world champion, but these two are little world champions and totally delightful."

Sarah said a contract played by Arti – 6NT making on a squeeze for a 13-IMP pickup – "made the match." They didn't seem too disappointed to learn they would no longer be eligible for limited events. "This is icing on the cake," said Sarah.

In second place with a score of 107.76 VPs was the team captained by Margie Cole of New York, NY, playing with Sandra Rimstedt, Cecilia Dwyer Rimstedt and Marion Michielsen.

Close behind in third place with 107.54 VPs was Linda Lewis, playing with Kristen Onsgard, Ljudmila Kamenova and Giorgia Botta.

President's Cup North American Pairs Flight C on Sunday by a little more than a board.

Brezak and Sawczuk scored 64% and 61% on Saturday to qualify in second place. They held that position in the first final session with a 59% and took the lead in the second final with a 56.77%.

Brezak and Sawczuk were exhausted after having played the entire tournament, including five national events: the Lebharr IMP Pairs, the NABC+ Open Pairs, the 0–10,000 Knockout and the 0–3000 Pairs.

"We're not used to playing from ahead," Brezak said.

"The other guys have been really consistent," Sawczuk said of the pair who were ahead of them on the first day. "I didn't feel like we were getting as many gifts."

The win leaves Sawczuk needing just 0.7 black points to make Life Master.

Concerned about a couple of bidding misunderstandings that occurred earlier in the last session, Sawczuk tried to go for a swing on the last board, but it wasn't necessary as they were already well ahead at that point.

In second, from District 3, were Prakash Malkani of East Brunswick NJ and Shriram Phadke of Plainsboro NJ, who had been in third place after the qualifying sessions.

USBF Junior program coordinator Amber Lin noted that Juniors placed first, seventh, eighth, ninth and 10th in the event, limited to players who were not Life Masters as of the start of the qualifying cycle.

"It's a grind," Powell said. "We really didn't think we'd win. It was a lot of fun."

The second-place pair from District 17, Steven Strong and Nick Evens of the Denver area, qualified in 31st place, scoring 60.46% in the first final to climb to fifth place and 58.46% to take second.

The event is limited to players under 3000 masterpoints.
