Neil Silverman of Phoenix AZ and Mark Itabashi of Newport Beach CA are the winners of the Oshlag Fast Pairs. Sitting in fourth place after the first final session, they posted a 60% second final session to surge into first. They finished with a combined score of 1686.53 (51 top).

Husband-and-wife pair Radu Nistor and Raluca Nistor of New York NY finished second with a combined score of 1679.58.

In third with a combined score of 1662.66 were the Bishel brothers, John and Tom, from Columbus OH.

Fleisher dominates Spingold

In a convincing performance from the Round of 64 to the final, the team captained by Martin Fleisher of New York, playing with Thomas Bessis, Sebastiaan Drijver, Chip Martel, Sjoert Brink and Cedric Lorenzini, captured another Spingold Teams title.

Fleisher led at the end of every quarter in every match; their historical semifinal score will be a tough record to beat.

In the final, after the first quarter Fleisher took a 70–19 lead over Andy

Chengs win Red Ribbon Pairs

Peng Cheng and Xiaoyu Cheng of Saratoga CA won the Bean Red Ribbon Pairs on Sunday. It's their first limited national win; they came in second in the Bruce LM-6000 Pairs last week and Peng placed second in last year's North American Pairs Flight B.

The Chengs, a husband and wife, scored 59.32% and 50.31% on Saturday to qualify in ninth place out of 36 qualifiers. On Sunday they scored 56.39% and 65.14% to win by a board and two-fifths.

The Chengs came for the Grand National Teams Flight B; this was their first time attending the entirety of an NABC. Peng started playing in 1979 and his partnership with Xiaoyu formed when they were in grad school at Stanford. They played regularly until 2005, then sporadically for a few years until they took a break, coming back a couple years ago.

In second were first-day leaders Hamilton Sawczuk of Baltimore MD and Jacob Baron of New York NY.

The event is limited to players under 3000 masterpoints with a ribbon qualification.

Hometown team wins 10K Mixed Swiss

With a score of 95.85 VPs, Sarah Wahl and Jackson Wahl of Minneapolis MN, playing with Linus Bendel-Stenzel of Richfield MN and Richard Lawson of Plymouth MN, are the winners of the NABC 0-10,000 Mixed Swiss.

"I've never played with Linus before," said Lawson. "Not bad for a first-time partnership."

Lawson has had a tremendous tournament, winning three events: The Goldman Grand National Teams, Flight A, a regional fast pairs and now the 10K Mixed Swiss.

Everyone agreed the Wahls were solid.

In second place with a score of 95.64 VPs were Randi Adelman of Teaneck NJ, Ryan Connors of Alexandria VA, Marc Sylvester of Edinboro PA and Gloria McDevitt of Medford MA.

Wahl suffered a 3-IMP loss to Adelman in the second round but then won all their matches to secure the victory by a fraction of a VP.

Those two teams were significantly ahead of third place, the team captained by Shelley Burns, who finished with 78.84 VPs.

Bakke wins Fishbein

Christian Bakke of Norway won the Fishbein Trophy for winning the most masterpoints at the Summer NABC. Bakke won the von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs (190), placed second in the Roth Swiss Teams (85.71) and made the quarterfinals of the Spingold (80) for a total of 355.71. He was 3 points ahead of David Berkowitz.
